


























Dear Biathlon Friends.

It is with great satisfaction that I welcome you to the IBU Summer Biathlon World Championships in Nové Město na Moravě, Czech republic.

In these unusual and uncertain times, the individuals, companies, and sporting federations need to find ways to shore up all of their capacities to keep developing while waiting for the worldwide pandemics to be at last put under control. When we prepared for the 2020/2021 season, there were many more questions than answers lingering in front of our eyes. We were sure of one thing only: the health of the athletes and all participating stakeholders must be an absolute priority. We spent many hours, organised countless 'video-call meetings', and consulted what we believe are the best experts from the relevant fields to prepare a comprehensive plan of measures that allowed us to have an exciting and successful winter season. I am confident that we have set up a set of protocols we can rely on in the future as well, for it has proved effective in very challenging circumstances.

The IBU Summer Biathlon World Championships are returning after a one-year of COVID-19 in-duced break. They bear significant value for our sport as they represent a subtle start of a slow build-up towards the winter season. While they have rarely been an event that would suggest things to come in the winter season, they are nevertheless the first sporting summit of the biathlon family in the new season. They represent a chance for athletes and coaches

to exchange first impressions after their summer training. The IBU Summer World Championships are also an event that gets the attention of the world's sporting media. They put biathlon back in the news and in the minds of fans. They can also be a confidence booster for the athletes who might have gone through technical changes in the spring and summer months and need to see how they can apply them under pressure.

Towards the end of the 2019/2020 season, Nové Město na Moravě hosted the BMW IBU World Cup. Although the organisers sold out the event after the euphoria that surrounded the highly successful IBU World Championships 2020 in Antholz - Anterselva, the fast-spreading virus forced us to stage the event without spectators. Nové Město na Moravě also impeccably organised the last two weeks of the competitions before last season's finals. We thus have great trust in the organising committee of Nove Mesto and in the protocols we have established.

That is why I am looking forward to the IBU Summer Biathlon World Championships with quiet confidence and optimism.

I wish us all an exciting summer week of biathlon.

A.8 LIABILITY/INSURANCE

The organizer shall not be held liable for any damages caused to persons or material/equipment. All participants must be covered by sufficient health, accident and liability insurance. By submitting the entry form the respected National Federation confirms that all persons registered are covered by the appropriate insurance (in accordance with 1.5.1.2. IBU Event and Competition Rules).

A.9 REGULATIONS REGARDING THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF RIFLES, AMMUNITION AND RADIO EOUIPMENT.

Rifle and ammunition import

All participants shall arrive in the Czech Republic with a signed Official Invitation letter, which will be sent to all National Federations individually by the Czech Biathlon Union. Printed or electronic version of the Invitation document is also recommended.

Owners of the European rifle license (ERL) need no other documents when entering the Czech Rep.

Participants without the ERL entering the Czech Republic shall present the Official Invitation letter together with the Waybill for transit of firearms and ammunition (WTFA) form, which either need to be approved by a CZE Consulate in their respective countries or at the Prague airport after arriving in the Czech Republic (100 EUR fee applies).

The WTFA Application Form (including a version with fill-in instructions) can be downloaded at www.biathlonnmnm.cz/en/info-for-teams/.

Operation of radio equipment

All teams are allowed to use either free frequencies included in the list of free frequencies or special reserved pay frequencies ordered according to the instructions issued by the organizer with the Czech Telecommunication Agency.

A.10 VISA REGULATIONS

Citizens of the following IBU member countries need the entry visa when travelling to the Czech Republic: ARM, BLR, CHN, GEO, KAZ, KGZ, MNG, RUS, TUR, UZB.

All the above-mentioned NFs must send the completed form "Application for Visa (the name list of participants for Visa)" to the Czech Biathlon Union for authorisation. This document will be subsequently sent back for Visa application.

Requests for authorisation must be submitted to the Czech Biathlon Union not later than 24 July 2021.



A.11 COVID-19 PROCEDURES

Due to the still very dynamic and unpredictable COVID-19 situation including constant changes within the respective legislation/regulations, the detailed event related COVID-19 procedures for the SBWCH 2021 in Nové Město na Moravě/CZE will be published only four (4) weeks prior to the event, i.e. 27 July 2021.

As long as not stated differently from the IBU side, the IBU Event Guidelines COVID-19 do apply with a similar on site procedure as during the IBU winter biathlon events 2020/21.



B.1 TRANSPORT

Regarding the COVID-19 situation the Organizing Committee is able to ensure transport of the teams from the Prague Airport ONLY. One transport to Nové Město and back is free of charge.

Additional transport have to be payed according to the price list.

Price list transport Prague => NMNM / NMNM => Prague Airport:

1 – 4 persons 150 EUR (personal car – one way)
 5 – 7 persons 200 EUR (minivan – one way)
 8 – 20 persons 400 EUR (bus – one way)
 21 – 40 persons 550 EUR (bus – one way)

Transportation between the places of accommodation and the competition venue is organized and covered by the OC. The local transport in NMNM during competition by the shuttle buses or minivans is according to the organizer's time schedule free of charge.

Transport requests must be submitted to the OC together with the entry by numbers, stating type of travel, time of arrival, number of people and amount of baggage by 24 July 2021.

B.2 ACCOMMODATION AND STAY

The deadline for binding changes in accommodation requests is set to 10 Augist 2021 – the day of the official IBU online registration by names.

If any accommodation is not used in full as requested – or partly – without submission of notice by the official deadline, the entering federation will be held liable for the costs. The entire period for which the hotel is contracted shall be paid for. Earlier departure or changes made without notification will not be considered.

Allocation of teams by hotels will be published in the Team Info document.

B.3 PRIZE MONEY

In order to carry out the bank transfer to the athletes who have earned the prize money the following information must be provided:

- Name of the bank
- IBAN, SWIFT
- Account number (national), bank code number (national)

All athletes who earned the prize money must come to the Competition Office in person and sign a document confirming the receipt of the Prize money. All athletes are responsible for the provision of the correct information when signing the payment form. Prize money will only be transferred to accounts confirmed by the signature.

Top 6 athletes in Men & Women categories will be awarded the respected prize money in each event of the SBWCH 2021:

1st 5,000 EUR - 2nd 3,500 EUR - 3rd 2,500 EUR
 4th 2,000 EUR; 5th 1,250 EUR; 6th 1,000 EUR

C5. ROLLER SKIS, HELMETS

According to the rules the use of helmets is obligatory at all trainings and competitions (IBU E&C Rules Annex D 3.2.1). Helmets have to be worn & fixed correctly – not with backside in front.

Roller skis for Official Trainings (Wednesday, Thursday, Friday) and Competitions will be provided by the IBU. Roller ski distribution will take place close to the team cabins.

Roller skis have to be given back immediately after the end of Official Training (including Friday afternoon) and/or Competition.








Super Sprint Qualification 4,5 km

Super Sprint Final 7,5 km Pursuit Junior Women + Women 7,5 km




