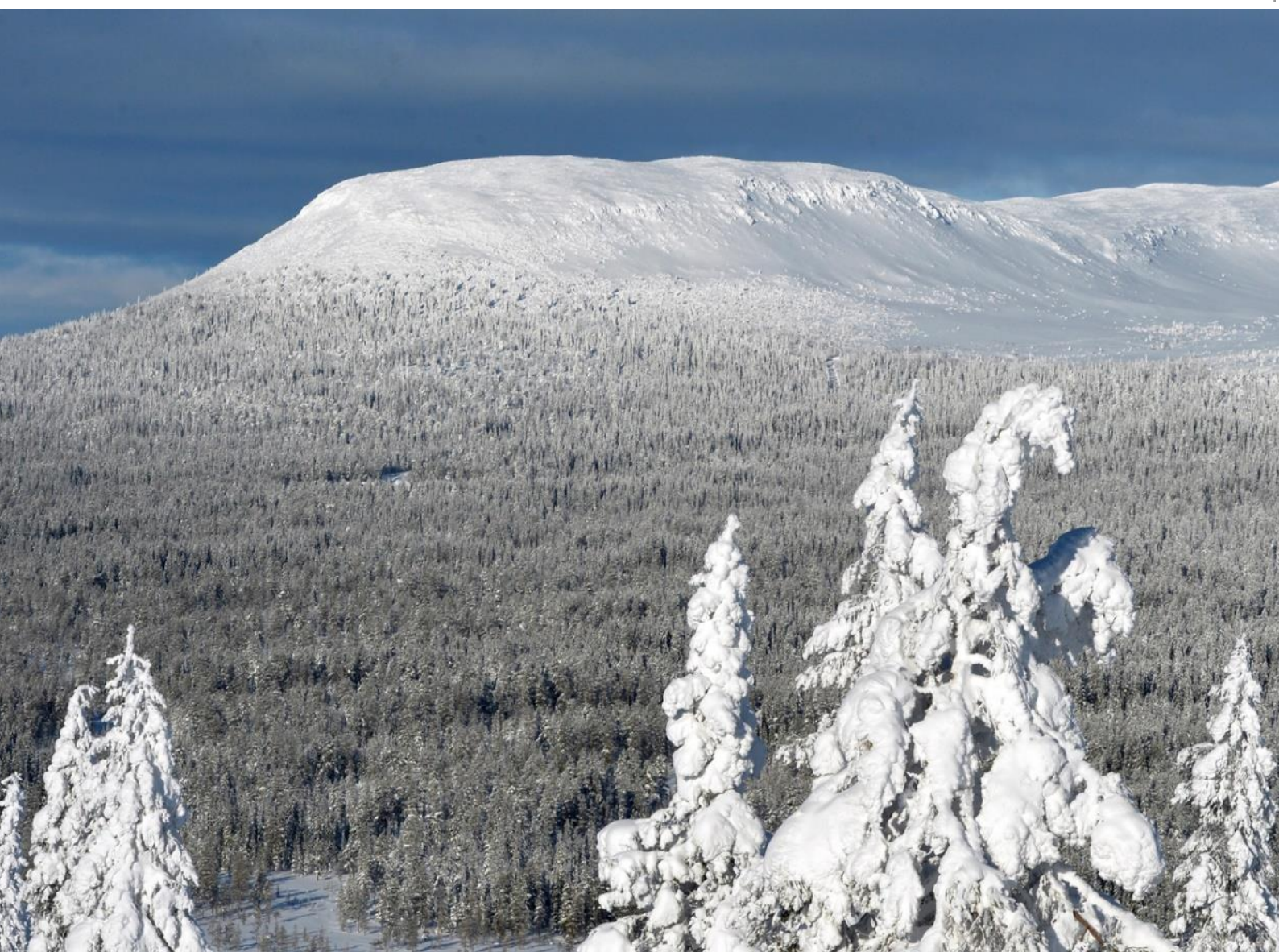

A 11. Import and Export of Rifles and Ammunition

To be allowed to import rifles and ammunition into Sweden, each nation must be able to show valid import permissions.

To facilitate your arrival and departure at the customs, please fill in the form "Application Form for import of Rifles and Ammunition" (Appendix A) and send it to the organizer no later than **25.10.2021**.

It is better to enter more athletes and/or rifles per nation than the actual quantity than too few. (This is the Police permission that all teams, except NOR, SWE and FIN, must have).

The fee is € 100

Payment will be carried out in cash or card at the Competition office before leaving Idre.

OC Idre will send all requested documents (police import permission and a special customs document), and you bring them with you when entering and leaving Sweden.

*Before leaving Idre and Sweden – very important – you must make sure the customs document has the correct information (border/flight). **All changes must be told to the Competition Office.***

Please remember to send the Appendix A no later than 14 days before arrival.
